WHEREAS, the City Council, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes §§ 417.01, 417.02, and 417.03, has the authority to adopt a resolution by majority vote to oppose a petition for dissolution; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, by a majority vote of its members, has determined that the City of Twin Lakes **shall** oppose the petition for dissolution and shall take immediate action to notify the appropriate authorities; and

WHEREAS, Town Law Center and attorney Jason Hill are the city's attorneys

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The City Council, by a majority vote, hereby adopts this Resolution 2025-15 opposing the petition for dissolution identified as CAH 71-0330-41314; DC-7 filed by Jean Epland.
2. The city council authorizes and directs Town Law Center to vehemently defend against the petition and to be in contact on a regular basis with the City Clerk/Treasurer for evidence, records, and updates.
