**WHEREAS**, a Petition for Detachment of certain properties from the City of Elmore has been filed with the Minnesota Office of Administrative Hearings as Docket Number OAH 80-0330-35243 by the property owners James M. Koppen and Kandis A. Koppen, Trustees of the Trust Agreement of James and Kandis Koppen, and Marlyn Hagedorn; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Elmore initially opposed the detachment action and filed a Petition in Opposition to the Detachment; and


**WHEREAS**, after further review of the matter and after mediation, the City and property owners have determined that it is in the best interests of all parties to allow the detachment to occur with conditions.

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Elmore that:


