## ORDINANCE NO. 1-84

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE COPORATE LIMITS
OF THE CITY OF ELKTON TO INCLUDE CERTAIN
UNINCORPORATED (UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING
200 ACRES IN AREA) ABUTTING UPON THE CITY LIMITS

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated  $\underline{\textit{FEB}}$ ,  $\underline{\textit{I6}}$ , 1984, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the council on the  $\underline{\textit{LFH}}$  day of  $\underline{\textit{MARCH}}$ , 1984; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all owners; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the town board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the city limits at the northern boundary thereof;

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELKTON, MINNESOTA ORDAINS:

Section 1. The city council hereby determines (1) that the territory described herein abuts upon the city limits and is about to become urban or suburban in character; and (2) that none of the territory is now included within the limits of any city.


Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the city are hereby extended to include the unplatted land describes as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the city as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof: (East 250 feet of the NE%, Section 2-102N-R16W, containing approximately 15.5 acres.

Section 3. Filing. The city clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Board, the Secretary of State, the Town Clerk, and the County Auditor.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3, and approval of the ordinance by the Minnesota Municipal Board.
