Ordinance No. 2751
AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE
LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WINONA, MINNESOTA,
TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED LAND

WHEREAS, a Petition dated January 7, 1985, was presented to the City Council for the annexation of certain lands hereinafter described, and

WHEREAS, the provisions of Minnesota Statutes Section 414.033, Subd. 5, have been complied with to date, and

WHEREAS, it appears to be the appropriate time for the City Council to make a determination regarding the annexation,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WINONA DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. The corporate limits of the City of Winona, Minnesota, are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described on Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 2. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Board, the Secretary of State, the Board of the Winona Township, and the Winona County Auditor.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect pursuant to the terms of the statute.

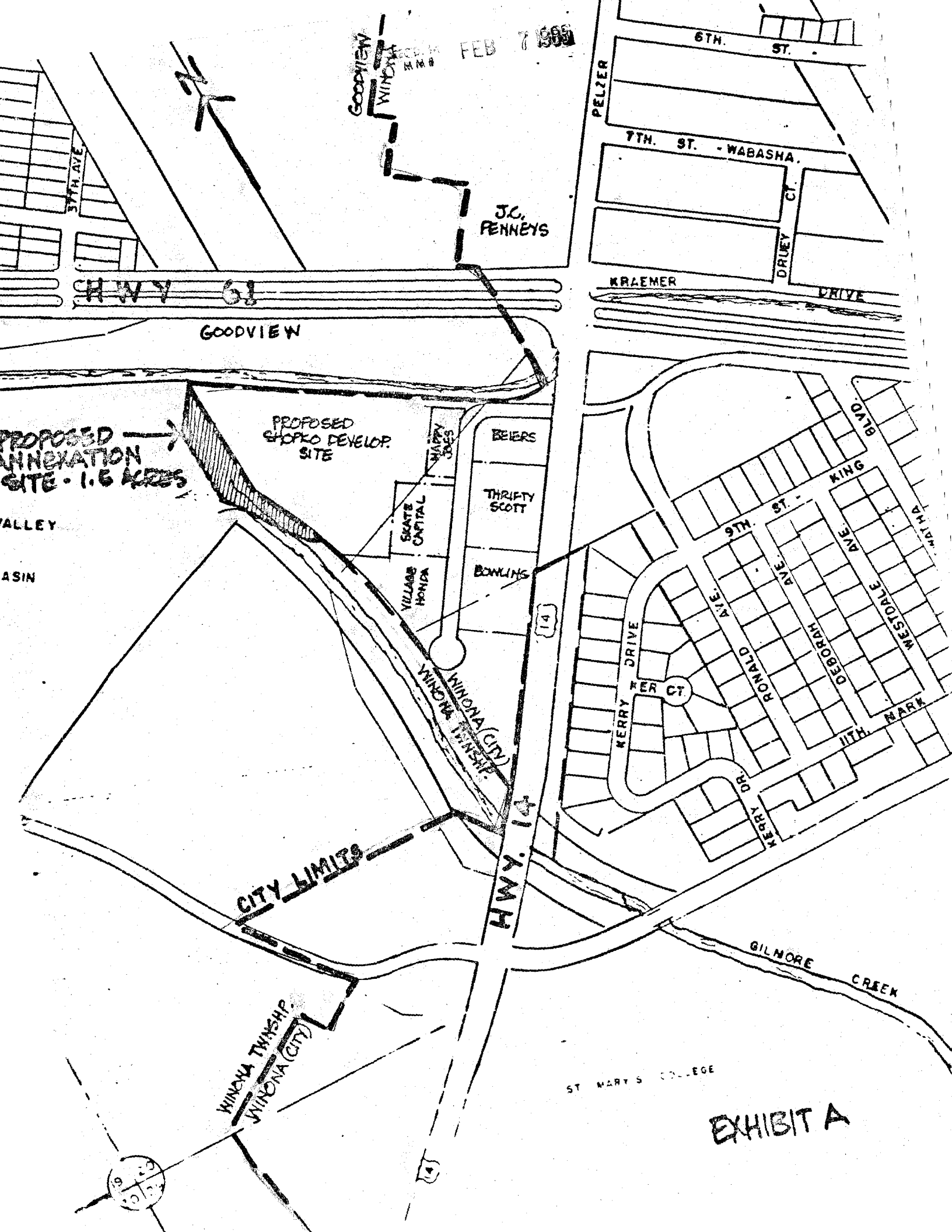
