AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF DENNISON TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA ABUTTING UPON THE CITY LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated January 24, 1985, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the council on the 5th day of February, 1985; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all owners; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the town board, or the governing body of any munincipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the city limits at the western boundary thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF DENNISON ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. The city council hereby determines (1) that the property described herein abuts upon the city limits and is or is about to become urban or suburban in character; and (2) that none of the territory is now included within the limits of any city.

SECTION 2. TERRITORY ANNEXED. The corporate limits of the city are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the city as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

Beginning at the southeast corner of the Northeast Quarter of Section 24, Township 111 North, Range 19 West, thence West along said quarter line approximately 151 feet 3 inches, to a point where said quarter section line intersects with the easterly line of the right-of-way of the Chicago Great Western Railway; thence northwesterly along said east right-of-way line, a distance of 430 feet; thence northeasterly to a point on the east line of said section 24, 430 feet north of the southeast corner of the northeast quarter, thence south to the point of beginning. All lying in Rice County, Minnesota.

SECTION 3. FILING. The city clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Munincipal Board,

the Secretary of State, the Town Clerk, and the County Auditor.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3, and approval of the ordinance by the Minnesota Munincipal Board.
