

ORDINANCE NO. 2686

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO ANNEXATION;  
ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF ROCHESTER A  
PORTION OF THE WEST HALF OF THE WEST HALF  
OF SECTION 14; AND A PART OF THE EAST 120  
ACRES OF SECTION 15; TOWNSHIP 107 NORTH,  
RANGE 14 WEST.

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCHESTER DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. A request has been filed with the Common Council of the City of Rochester, to annex certain lands owned by the City which are hereinafter described. The land in question is located in Cascade Township, Olmsted County, Minnesota, and is described as follows:

That part of the West Half of the West Half of Section 14, Township 107 North, Range 14 West, Olmsted County, Minnesota, described as follows:

Commencing at the southwest corner of the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 14; thence South 89 degrees 58 minutes 22 seconds East, assumed bearing, along the south line of said Section 14, a distance of 226.82 feet; thence North 00 degrees 19 minutes 50 seconds West, 757.05 feet for the point of beginning; thence North 89 degrees 43 minutes 42 seconds West, 225.31 feet to the west line of said Section 14; thence North 00 degrees 12 minutes 56 seconds West, along said west line, 2250.26 feet to a point distant 2271.60 feet southerly of, as measured along said west line, from the northwest corner of said Section 14; thence South 89 degrees 42 minutes 41 seconds East, 550.81 feet; thence South 00 degrees 19 minutes 50 seconds East, 1421.74 feet; thence North 89 degrees 58 minutes 22 seconds West, 330.00 feet; thence South 00 degrees 19 minutes 50 seconds East, 826.98 feet to the point of beginning.

Also:

That part of the east 120 acres of Section 15, Township 107 North, Range 14 West, Olmsted County, Minnesota, described as follows:

Commencing at the southeast corner of said Section 15; thence North 00 degrees 12 minutes 56 seconds West, assumed bearing, along the east line of said Section 15, a distance of 758.00 feet for the point of beginning; thence North 89 degrees 43 minutes 42 seconds West, 989.16 feet to the west line of the east 120 acres of said Section 15; thence North 00 degrees 12 minutes 18 seconds West, along said west line, 2250.55 feet; thence South 89 degrees 42 minutes 41 seconds East, 988.75 feet to the east line of said Section 15; thence South 00

degrees 12 minutes 56 seconds East, along said east line, 2250.26 feet to the point of beginning.

Containing 73.39 acres more or less.

Said petition has also been filed with the Town Board of Cascade Township, with the County Board of the County of Olmsted, and with the Minnesota Municipal Board, and the Town Board of Cascade Township has notified the City that it has no objections to the annexation of the above-described land.

Section 2. The quantity of land included in said petition is approximately 73.39 acres in size.

Section 3. The Common Council of the City of Rochester does hereby determine that the land described in Section 1 abuts upon the present territorial limits of the City of Rochester, is so conditioned as to be properly subjected to municipal government, and the annexation of said land will be in the best interest of the City of Rochester and the land described.

Section 4. Therefore, the land described in Section 1 above is hereby annexed, added to and made a part of the City of Rochester, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 5. Present and future owners of the lands annexed by this ordinance are hereby notified that in addition to the usual assessments, it is the intention of the Common Council to assess against benefited property all or a portion of the cost of any storm sewer, water tower, and trunk line sanitary sewer construction, heretofore or hereafter undertaken to serve the area annexed.

Section 6. Present and future owners of the lands annexed by this ordinance are hereby notified that it is the intention of the City of Rochester to provide electrical service through its Public Utility Department to any development on the lands annexed; and that said annexation by the City represents a commitment by the City to extend its electrical distribution facilities to serve said lands.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its official publication and from and after the filing of a certified copy hereof with the Minnesota Municipal board, the Cascade Town Clerk, the County Auditor, and the Secretary of State.
