PETITION FOR ANNEXATION

TO: THE CITY OF MONTEVIDEO

Your Petitioner, THE CHURCH OF ST. JOSEPH, respectfully represents and states to the City Council of the City of Montevideo as follows:

1. That it is the owner in fee of that certain tract of land in the County of Chippewa and State of Minnesota described as follows:

That part of the North Half of the Northwest Quarter (N½ NW½), Section Twenty (20), Township One Hundred Seventeen North (117N), Range Forty West (40W), described as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the North line of Section Twenty (20), Township One Hundred Seventeen (117), Range Forty (40), and the centerline of County State Aid Road No. 15; thence East 224 feet along the said North line to the Northwest corner of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NE½ NW½); thence East 606 feet along said North line of Section Twenty (20) to the point of beginning of the tract to be described; thence South 316.8 feet; thence South 49° 28' East a distance of 319 feet; thence North to the North line of Section Twenty (20); thence West to the point of beginning.

- 2. Your Petitioner requests that said premises be annexed to and included within the corporate limits of the City of Montevideo as provided in Minnesota Statutes § 414.033, Subd. 5.
