ORDINANCE NO.5, FIFTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING LAND TO THE CITY

WHEREAS, the following described land is owned by the City of Jackson, abuts upon the corporate limits of the City, and is not included in any other municipality; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Wisconsin, Jackson County, Minnesota, has requested that the City annex said land; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that annexation of said land will be in the best interests of the City, of Wisconsin Township, and of the territory affected,

Now, therefore, THE CITY OF JACKSON ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Land Annexed. The corporate limits of the City are hereby extended to include the tract in Jackson County, Minnesota, described as follows:

The North 108.00 feet of the West 100.00 feet of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty (30) in Township One Hundred Two (102) North of Range Thirty-four (34), West of the Fifth Principal Meridian;

and the same are hereby annexed to and included within the City as effectually as if they had originally been a part thereof.


SECTION 2. Zoning District. The land hereby annexed to and included within the City is hereby designated as an Agriculture Residence District, "RA".

SECTION 3. Filing. The City Administrator is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Board, the Secretary of State, the Jackson County Auditor, and the Clerk of Wisconsin Township, Jackson County, Minnesota.


SECTION 4. Effective date. This ordinance takes effect 14 days after its posting or publication and after its filing has been approved by the Municipal Board.

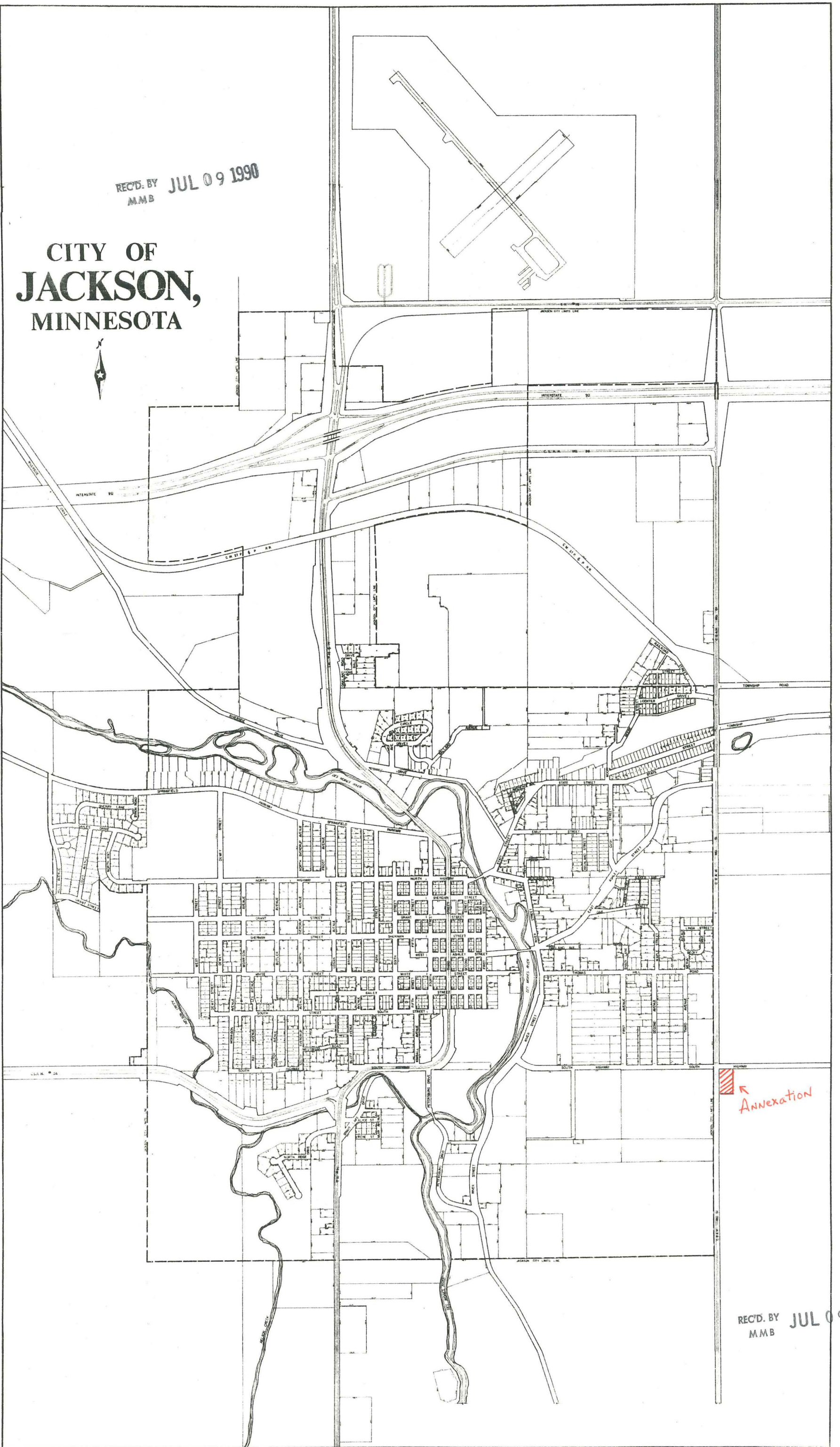
