Proposed Annexation to the City of Waverly

(Douglas Petition: 60.2 acres)

Good Morning:

The Town Board of Woodland Township, Wright County pursuant to a resolution duly adopted by the town board on August 3, 1992, hereby objects to the proposed annexation of the following described property to the City of Waverly for the following reasons:

1. The City of Waverly already has ample undeveloped land within the city limits on the north, west and south side of the City.

2. Woodland township since March of 1992 has been and is in the process of instituting their own planning and zoning. The township is in the process of working on a coordinated plan of a natural progression of managed growth. This proposed annexation would be contrary to sound planning.

3. The town board feels that both political parties will be funding low income housing. The primary goal of the Legislature is to create an opportunity for the people in this housing to train and hire in the area and also to be close to a ready employment base. At present Waverly does not have and is not close to job training centers and a ready employment base.

4. There is no development plan for 60.2 acres.
