It is hereby requested by: Northshore Mining Company, the sole property owner of the area

proposed for annexation to annex certain property described herein lying in the Town of Beaver

Bay to the City of Silver Bay, County of Lake, Minnesota.

The area proposed for annexation is described as follows:

Government Lot One (1), Section Seven (7), Township Fifty-five (55) North, Range Seven (7) West of the Fourth Principal Meridian.

Part of Government Lot Two (2), Section Seven (7), Township Fifty-five (55) North, Range Seven (7) West of the Fourth Principal Meridian, described as follows: Commencing at the Northwest corner of Section (7), Township Fifty-five (55) North, Range Seven (7) West of the Fourth Principal Meridian, Lake County Minnesota, thence southerly along the range line between Ranges Seven and Eight West a distance of 855.55 feet more or less to the intersection of the center line of Highway 61 as located November 25, 1947, and the Range line between Ranges Seven and Eight, thence turn to the left 128° 43' and go for a distance of 276.22', thence turn to the right 90° 00' along a line (hereinafter called line "A") and go for a distance of 250', which point is the point of beginning, thence along a projection of line "A" for a distance of 884.49', thence turn to the right 39° 38' and go to the shore of Lake Superior, thence go along the shore of Lake Superior, thence go along the shore of Lake Superior in an easterly direction to the intersection of the east line of Lot 2 and the shore of Lake Superior, thence Northerly along the east line of Lot 2 to the northeast corner thereof, thence westerly along the north line of Lot 2 to a point where the north line of Lot 2 intersects the center line of Highway 61 as located November 25, 1947, thence along the center line of Highway 61 to a point, which when measured along the center line of Highway 61, as located November 25, 1947 is 426.22' from the range line between Ranges 7 West and 8 West. thence southeasterly along a line parallel to line "A" previously described a distance of 150' to a point, thence southwesterly to point of beginning.

All that part of Government Lot Two (2) of Section Seven (7) in Township Fifty-five (55) North, Range Seven (7) West of the Fourth Principal Meridian, lying North of the center line of Highway No. 61 described as follows:

Commencing at the Northwest corner of Section 7, Township 55 North, Range 7 West of the Fourth Principal Meridian, Lake County, Minnesota, the point of beginning, thence Southerly along the range line between Range 7 and 8 West a distance of 855.55 feet more or less to the intersection of the center line of Highway No. 61 as located November 25, 1947, and the range line between Ranges 7 and 8, thence Northeasterly along the center line of said Highway to the intersection of said center line with the North line of Section 7, thence Westerly along said North line to the point of beginning. Including that portion of Highway No. 61 lying within said Government Lots One (1) and Two (2). 1. There is one property owner, the Petitioner, North Shore Mining Company, in the area proposed for annexation.

2. All property owners have signed this petition.

3. The population of the annexation area is zero.

4. Said property is unincorporated, abuts on the City's West boundary, and is not included within any other municipality.

5. The area of land to be annexed, in acres, is:

6. The reason for the requested annexation is: The City of Silver Bay, through lease with the property owner, intends to improve and develop the area for a planned Harbor of Refuge and Small Boat Landing.

7. All of the annexation area is or is about to become urban or suburban in character.

8. The area proposed for annexation is not included in any area that has already been designated for orderly annexation pursuant to M.S.A. § 414.0325.
