# AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN PROPERTY INTO THE CITY LIMITS OF FLOODWOOD 

The City Council ordains as follows:
WHEREAS, the City of Floodwood is the fee simple owner of certain real estate in St. Louis County, Minnesota legally described as follows:

Government Lot One (1), Section Seven (7), Township Fifty-one (51), North of Range Twenty (20), West of the Fourth Principal Meridian according to the U.S. Government Survey thereof, and

WHEREAS, the above-described real estate consists of 34.13 acres; and
WHEREAS, the above-described real property owned by the City of Floodwood abuts the city limits of the City of Floodwood and pursuant to Minnesotat Statute Section 414.033 subd. 2
(1) is deemed to be urban or suburban in character or is about to become so; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Floodwood has determined that it is in the best interest of the City that the above described real property be annexed into the city limits of Floodwood; and

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statute Section 414.033 subd. 2 (1) states that under these circumstances, the City Council may, by ordinance, declare the said land annexed to the municipality; and

WHEREAS, the above-described real property is suburban in character and the purpose of the annexation is to facilitate City policing of this City owned property.

NOW THEREFORE, the above described real property is annexed into the city limits of the City of Floodwood, Minnesota.
