The Minnesota Municipal Board has now processed and approved the above ordinance in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 414, and the Rules of Procedure.

The law requires that a copy of the annexation ordinance must be delivered immediately by the governing body of the municipality to the appropriate county auditor or auditors, and filed with the township and the Secretary of State. We recommend that you also file the annexation ordinance with the County Recorder. If you have population in the affected area, please contact the State Demographer's Office at (651) 296-9036 for forms.

The annexation is final upon the date the ordinance is approved by the Board, which is the date of this letter.

The Board notes that the concerns expressed by adjacent property owners and Town of Sibley regarding this annexation are well-founded. The representatives of the developer and the City stated that they would be working with the adjacent property owners and the Town to try to address their concerns as the development plans proceed. The Board shares the

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concerns of those opposed to this annexation. The action taken today because of statutory constraints relies on that expression of goodwill for the success of the entire area.
