ORDINANCE NO. 217, THIRD SERIES

THE WAS TO MORE

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LUVERNE TO INCLUDE CERTAIN LANDS OWNED BY THE LUVERNE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY AND ABUTTING THE CITY OF LUVERNE (161.87 Acres, IBP Area)

WHEREAS, the Luverne Economic Development Authority has filed a Petition dated October 13, 1998, requesting annexation to the City of Luverne of that certain real estate located in the County of Rock, State of Minnesota, described as follows:

The South Half of the Northeast Quarter (S ½ of NE ¼) of Section Sixteen (16) and Lots One (1) and Three (3) in said Section Sixteen (16), all in Township One hundred two (102) North, of Range Forty-five (45) West, of the 5th P.M.,

-and-

All that portion of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE ¼ of SE ¼) of Section Nine (9) in Township One hundred two (102) North, of Range Forty-five (45) West, lying Southerly of a line drawn parallel with and Fifty (50) feet distant Southerly, measured at right angles, from the center line of the railroad right-of-way as now located thereon, comprising approximately Forty-eight hundredths (0.48) of an acre, more or less,

-and-

The East Thirty (E.30) acres of all that part of the West half (W ½) of Section Sixteen (16), in Township One hundred two (102) North, of Range Forty-five (45) West of the 5th P.M., lying South of the Chicago, St. Paul, Minneapolis and Omaha Railroad right-of-way and North of the right-of-way of Interstate Highway No. 90; and

WHEREAS, the Luverne Economic Development Authority represents it is the <u>sole owner</u> of the property, that the population of the area is zero, and that the property is unincorporated, abuts on the westerly boundary of the City of Luverne, is not included with any other municipality, is not included in any boundary adjustment proceedings pending before the Minnesota Municipal Board, has a property area of 161.87 unplatted acres, is not presently served by public sewer facilities or public sewer facilities are not otherwise available, and is or about to become urban or suburban in character; and

WHEREAS, said property is currently served by the municipality's electric utility service, and the property owners have waived their right to receive notice pursuant to M.S. 4145.033, Subd. 13, regarding an estimate of the cost impact of any change in electric utility services, including rate changes and assessments, resulting from the annexation.

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NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Luverne, Minnesota, does ordain:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby determines and finds that the property abuts the municipality, that the area to be annexed is unplatted, that the area does not exceed 200 acres, that the area to be annexed is not presently served by public sewer facilities or public sewer facilities are not otherwise available, that the municipality has received a properly prepared Petition for Annexation from all of the owners of the property, that the area is appropriate for annexation by ordinance under M.S. 414.033, Subd. 5, and that the Petition complies with all the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 414.033.

- SEC. 2. The property is urban or suburban in nature or about to become so.
- SEC. 3. The property is currently served by the municipality's electric utility service and the property owners have waived their right to receive notice pursuant to M.S. 414.033, Subd. 13, regarding an estimate of the cost impact of any change in electric utility services, including rate changes and assessments, resulting from the annexation.
- SEC. 4. The corporate limits of the City of Luverne are hereby extended to include the property, and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the City of Luverne as if the property had originally been part thereof.
- SEC. 5. The City Clerk is directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Board, Luverne Township, the Rock County Auditor-Treasurer, and the Minnesota Secretary of State.
 - SEC. 6. That the area should be zoned I-2, General Industry District.

SEC. 7. This ordinance takes effect up	on its passage and publication and approval by the
Minnesota Municipal Board.
