AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WATERVILLE, MINNESOTA

WHEREAS, on August 6, 1999, the City of Waterville purchased the following parcel of unincorporated real property from Willard L. Goltz:

The Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 27, Township 109 North, Range 23 West, except the South 380 feet of the East 340 feet, Le Sueur County, Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, the northerly and easterly boundaries of the above-described tract of unincorporated property abuts the municipal limits of the City of Waterville; and

WHEREAS, the described land is now or about to become urban or suburban in character as it is now owned by the City and will become an industrial park for the City of Waterville; and

WHEREAS, the City of Waterville desires to annex the described land into the corporate limits of the City; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing is not necessary pursuant to the provisions of Minn. Stat. §414.033, Subd. 2 (1) and Subd. 2 (b) because the described property is now owned by the City of Waterville;

NOW, THEREFORE, **BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Waterville, Minnesota, as follows:

1. That the corporate limits of the City of Waterville, Minnesota, are hereby extended to include the property legally described as the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 27, Township 109 North, Range 23 West, except the South 380 feet of the East 340 feet thereof, Le Sueur County, Minnesota, and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the City of Waterville as if the property had originally been part thereof.

2. The City Administrator is directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Board, Waterville Township, the Le Sueur County Auditor and the Minnesota Secretary of State per Minn.
