

RESOLUTION OF WAIVER OF OBJECTION TO ANNEXATION

WHEREAS, the Township Board of Slayton Township, Murray County, Minnesota, has received a copy of a Petition for Annexation filed with the City Council of the City of Slayton, Murray County, Minnesota, which was signed by the sole owner of the land proposed to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, said land proposed to be annexed abuts the City of Slayton along the east and south boundaries of the land proposed to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, said land is urban or suburban in character;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Township Board of Slayton Township hereby waives the ninety (90) day period granted in M.S. 414.033, Subd. 5, to submit written objections to the Municipal Boundary Adjustments division of the Minnesota Office of Strategic and Long Range Planning and the City of Slayton so that the City of Slayton may, pursuant to M.S. 414.033, Subd. 5, annex the following described land:

A parcel of land in the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Nine (9), Township One Hundred Six North (106N), Range Forty-one (41), West of the 5th P.M., Murray County, Minnesota, described as follows: Beginning at the southwest corner of Lot One (1), Block One (1), Finley's Subdivision; thence west along and upon the north right of way line of Engebretson Street a distance of 290.40 feet; thence north and parallel to the west boundary line of said Lot One (1), Block One (1), Finley's Subdivision, a distance of 300.00 feet; thence east and parallel to the north right of way line of Engebretson Street a distance of 290.4 feet to the northwest corner of Lot One (1), Block One (1), Finley's Subdivision; thence south along and upon the west boundary line of Lot One (1), Block One (1), Finley's Subdivision a distance of 300.00 feet to the point of beginning and there terminating.
