ORDINANCE NO. 1.7017

An Ordinance Annexing Certain Unincorporated Property Owned by the City of Madelia Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes §414.033

WHEREAS, the City of Madelia has studied its municipal borders and the City's growth patterns and the City further desires to promote orderly growth and provide municipal services in an efficient manner; and

WHEREAS, the property which is the subject of this annexation is owned by the City of Madelia; and

WHEREAS, the City finds that the property proposed for annexation is or is about to become urban or suburban in character and the annexation by the City of Madelia is in the best interests of the property proposed for annexation and the area to be annexed is not presently served by public utilities; and

WHEREAS, none of the property which is the subject of this annexation is now included within the limits of any city or village; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to proceed with the annexation of said property by Ordinance pursuant to Minnesota Statutes §414.033;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Madelia as follows:

Section 1. The corporate limits of the City of Madelia are hereby amended to include the following described property currently in the jurisdiction of Madelia Township in Watonwan County, Minnesota, which property consists of approximately 155 acres, and the property is hereby annexed to and included within the corporate limits of the City pursuant to Minnesota Statutes §414.033 as if such property had originally been a part of the City:

See Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof.

<u>Section 2</u>. Pursuant to the City zoning ordinance, the City Council hereby designates the above described tract of land being annexed herein as agricultural.

Section 3. The amount required to pay the filing fee of Minnesota Planning, Municipal Boundary Adjustments for this annexation ordinance is hereby appropriated for such purpose and the City Administrator is directed to make the necessary filings and provide required information to Minnesota Planning, Municipal Boundary Adjustments, the Township of Madelia, the auditor of Watonwan County, and the Minnesota Secretary of State.

<u>Section 4</u>. This Ordinance is effective upon passage and publication pursuant to Minnesota Statutes and approval by Minnesota Planning, Municipal Boundary Adjustments.
