Dear Ms. Sawatzky:

On May 17, 2007, the Office of Administrative Hearings approved the above ordinance in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 414, and the Rules of Procedure. The annexation is final upon the date the ordinance is approved.

The city and township have agreed that reimbursement of taxes, pursuant to Minn. Stat. 414.036, will be paid to the township by the city in accordance with the provision in the above-referenced ordinance.

The law requires that a copy of the annexation ordinance must be delivered immediately by the governing body of the municipality to the appropriate county auditor or auditors, and filed with the township. We recommend that you also file the annexation ordinance with the County Recorder. <u>This office will file a copy of the ordinance with the Secretary of State.</u> However, you must now complete the election precinct boundary change process in coordination with the Office of the Secretary of State.
