That, it is hereby requested by all of the property owners of the area proposed for annexation to annex certain property described herein lying in the Town of Field to the City of Cook, County of St. Louis, Minnesota.

That, the area proposed for annexation is described as follows:

The Northeast Quarter of Section Thirteen (13), Township Sixty-two (62) North, Range Nineteen (19) West lying South of County Road #115 and lying North of U.S. Highway #53, except that part of the East 660.00 ft. lying 210.00 ft. South of and parallel to the North line of Government Lot 2 in said Northeast Quarter lying North of the Little Fork River.

1. There are four property owners in the area proposed for annexation.
2. The area proposed for annexation abuts the municipality and is 120 acres or less, and is not presently served by public wastewater facilities or public wastewater facilities are not otherwise available.
3. Said property is unincorporated, abuts on the City's West boundary line and is not included within any other municipality.
4. The area of land proposed for annexation is 94.2 acres.
5. The reason for the requested annexation is to allow the property owners to be served by public wastewater facilities and municipal wastewater facilities, and other municipal purposes.


