## ORDINANCE NO. 12-100, FOURTH SERIES CITY OF NEW ULM, BROWN COUNTY, MINNESOTA

AN ORDINANCE FOR ANNEXATION OF PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF NEW ULM PURSUANT TO MINNESOTA STATUTES SECTION 414.033.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW ULM:

## **RECITALS**

WHEREAS, the City of New Ulm has received a Petition for Annexation of certain properties located in Section 14, Township 110, Range 31, all in Brown County, Minnesota, legally described below, from the owners of such land, requesting that such properties be annexed to the City of New Ulm; and

WHEREAS, the subject property consists of less than 120 acres, abuts the city limits of the City of New Ulm, and is not presently served by public sewer facilities; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on the petition for annexation before the City Council of the City of New Ulm on March 6, 2007, after proper notice under Minnesota Statutes section 414.033, subd. 2b; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of New Ulm has deemed the described property to be urban or suburban in character or about to become so; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City of New Ulm and its residents that the described property be annexed to and incorporated into the city limits of the City of New Ulm pursuant to Minn. Statutes, Section 414.033;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW ULM:

SECTION I. That the following described property is hereby declared to be annexed to and incorporated into the City of New Ulm with the same force and effect as if such property had originally been part of the City of New Ulm:

The SE¼ of the SE¼, except the west 140 feet thereof, Section 14, Township 110, Range 31, Brown County, Minnesota, which property will be platted as that part of the Menard Subdivision lying westerly of the east line of the SE¼ of SE¼, Section 14, Township 110, Range 31, and northerly of the south line of Section 14, Township 110, Range 31.

SECTION II. That the property described in Section I shall be designated and zoned as B-3 (General Business District) for purposes of use of districts pertinent to zoning.

SECTION III. That the City Engineer is hereby directed to make the changes to the official map of the City of New Ulm evidencing the annexation and zoning of the property described herein in and to the City of New Ulm.

SECTION IV. That a copy of this ordinance shall be filed with the Office of Administrative Hearings, the Brown County Auditor, the Brown County Recorder, the Milford Township Board, and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.

SECTION V. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after passage, approval, and publication of this ordinance and upon approval of said annexation by the State of Minnesota and filing of such approval as required by law.



## MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT between City of New Ulm, Minnesota and

Milford Township, Brown County, Minnesota

The undersigned officials of the City of New Ulm, Minnesota and Milford Township, Brown County, Minnesota, make this memorandum of agreement for the purpose of reciting the terms of agreement for reimbursement of lost tax revenue to Milford Township as a result of annexation of property into the City of New Ulm, the legal description of which property is set forth below. The agreement for reimbursement of lost tax revenue is made pursuant to the requirements of Minnesota Statutes, section 414.036.

Legal description of annexed property:

The SE¼ of the SE¼, except the west 140 feet thereof, Section 14, Township 110, Range 31, Brown County, Minnesota, which property will be platted as that part of the Menard Subdivision lying westerly of the east line of the SE¼ of SE¼, Section 14, Township 110, Range 31, and northerly of the south line of Section 14, Township 110, Range 31.

Agreement:

The City of New Ulm will reimburse to Milford Township four years' lost tax revenue, in the total amount of \$3,240.40, payable in one installment upon approval of the annexation. There are no outstanding special assessments related to this property, nor any debt incurred by the township prior to the annexation and attributable to the property.

This memorandum of agreement is executed on June 8, 2012.
