**NOTICE OF RECONVENED HEARING**

The evidentiary hearing concerning this Petition will be held on September 9, 2013, beginning at 2:00 p.m. and will continue thereafter each day, until September 17, 2013, as necessary in the Council Chambers, Duluth City Hall, 411 West 1<sup>st</sup> Street, Duluth, Minnesota before Administrative Law Judge James LaFave. This is a continuation of the first hearing in this matter held on March 6, 2013.

The only formal parties to this proceeding to date are the City of Proctor, Midway Township, and the City of Duluth. The City of Proctor has petitioned the State for authority to annex certain land.

Please be advised that opportunity for **public comment** will be on Wednesday, September 11, 2013, beginning at 7:00 p.m., in the Council Chambers at the Duluth City Hall. Any person interested in this matter may comment at this time.

The hearing will be conducted pursuant to the procedure set out in Minnesota Rules, Chapter 6000 as supplemented by Minnesota Rules 14.57 - 14.62. The property proposed for annexation is described as follows:


That portion of Township Forty-Nine North (T. 49N), Range Fifteen West (R. 15W) located within the County of St. Louis, Minnesota, and designated as Midway Township, more properly described as the Westerly One-Half (W 1/2) of Township 49 North, Range 15 West, St. Louis County, Minnesota.

Following the close of the hearing, the Chief Administrative Law Judge will issue a written final decision pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 414 and the referral from the Municipal Boundary Adjustment Unit.
