## ORDER APPROVING ANNEXATION ORDINANCE

On December 15, 2014, the City of Aitkin (City) adopted Ordinance Number 370 (Ordinance) annexing certain real property (Property) owned by Paul Fischer legally described as follows:

The West Nine Hundred-Ninety (990) feet of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NE¼ SE¼), of Section Twenty-four (24), Township Fortyseven (47), Range Twenty-seven (27), (Aitkin Township parcel).

Based upon a review of the Ordinance, the Chief Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

## **ORDER**

- 1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033 (2014), the Ordinance is deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly supports this Order.
- 2. Pursuant to the terms of the Ordinance and this Order, the Property is annexed to the City of Aitkin.
- 3. As allowed by Minn. Stat. § 414.036 (2014), the City will reimburse Aitkin Township (Township) for all or part of the Property annexed at the rate of \$210.12 each year for two years. There are no special assessments or debt incurred by the Township on the subject property for which reimbursement is required.
