**ORDER APPROVING  
ANNEXATION ORDINANCE**

On May 21, 2015, the city of Zumbrota (City) adopted Ordinance Number 2015-01 (Ordinance) annexing certain real property (Property) owned by Kenneth Olson Trust and Lynn Olson Trust legally described as follows:


That part of the south 548.10 feet of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 26, Township 110, Range 16, Goodhue County, Minnesota, which lies southwesterly of the southwesterly right of way line of State Highway Number 52, as platted and designated on MINNESOTA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION RIGHT OF WAY PLAT NO. 25-80, as filed in the Goodhue County Recorder's Office. Containing 11.103 acres, more or less. Subject to all easements and restrictions of record.

Based upon a review of the Ordinance, the Chief Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

**ORDER**

1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033 (2014), the Ordinance is deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly supports this Order.
2. Pursuant to the terms of the Ordinance and this Order, the Property is **ANNEXED** to the city of Zumbrota.
3. Pursuant to the agreement of the parties and as allowed by Minn. Stat. § 414.036 (2014), the City will reimburse Minneola Township (Township) as stated in Ordinance Number 2015-01. There are no special assessments or debt incurred by the Township on the Property for which reimbursement is required
