**ORDER APPROVING
ANNEXATION ORDINANCE**

On July 1, 2015, the city of Sauk Centre (City) adopted Ordinance No. 759 (Ordinance) annexing certain real property (Property) legally described as follows:

Lot One (1), Block One (1), of Rieland's Addition, Section 8, Township 126, Range 34W, Stearns County, Minnesota.

Based upon a review of the Ordinance, the Chief Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

ORDER

1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033 (2014), the Ordinance is deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly supports this Order.
2. Pursuant to the terms of the Ordinance and this Order, the Property is **ANNEXED** to the City.
3. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.036 (2014), the City will reimburse Sauk Centre Township (Township) as stated in Ordinance Number 759.

NOTICE
