**ORDER APPROVING  
ANNEXATION ORDINANCE**

On October 6, 2015, the city of Winsted (City) adopted Ordinance Number 0-15-07 (Ordinance) annexing certain real property (Property) owned by the Estate of Darlene Gutknecht legally described as follows:

That part of Government Lot 4, Section 11, Township 117 North, Range 27 West, McLeod County, Minnesota, described as follows:

Beginning at the southwest corner of said Government Lot 4; thence northerly, along the west line of said Government Lot 4 a distance of 710.49 feet; thence easterly, deflecting to the right 90 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds 610.50 feet; thence southerly, parallel with said west line to a point on the south line of said Government Lot 4; thence westerly, along said south line to the point of beginning.

Based upon a review of the Ordinance, the Chief Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

**ORDER**

1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033 (2014), the Ordinance is deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly supports this Order.
2. Pursuant to the terms of the Ordinance and this Order, the Property is **ANNEXED** to the City.
3. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.036 (2014), the City will reimburse Winsted Township (Township) as stated in Ordinance Number 0-15-07.
