In the Matter of the Annexation of Certain Real Property to the City of Hector from Hector Township (MBAU Docket A-7949)

ORDER APPROVING ANNEXATION ORDINANCE

On September 14, 2015, the city of Hector (City) adopted Ordinance Number 2015-1 (Ordinance) annexing certain real property (Property) owned by the City legally described as follows:

Parts of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NE ¼ of NE ¼) of Section Twenty-eight (28), Township One Hundred Fifteen North (115N), Range Thirty-two West (32W), in Renville County Minnesota, and further described as follows: Beginning at the N.E. Corner of Section 28, T. 115 N., R. 32 N.; thence along the North line thereof, west a distance of 1192 feet; thence south and parallel to the east line of said Section 28 to the northerly Right-of-way line of the Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul and Pacific Railroad; thence southeasterly along said Railroad Right-of-way line to the centerline of Judicial Ditch No. 15; thence northeasterly along said Ditch centerline to its intersection with the east line of Section 28 aforesaid; thence along said east line of Section 28 north to the point of beginning, and

Beginning at a point 313 feet south of the north line of Section 28 and 1107 feet west of the N.E. Corner of said Section 28 aforesaid; thence north 313 feet to the north line of Section 28; thence along said north line west to the west line of NW ¼ of NE ¼ of Section 28; thence along said west line south 108 feet; thence east and parallel to the north line of Section 28 aforesaid, a distance of 1100 feet; thence southeasterly to the point of beginning.

Based upon a review of the Ordinance, the Chief Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

ORDER

1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033 (2014), the Ordinance is deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly supports this Order.

2. Pursuant to the terms of the Ordinance and this Order, the Property is **ANNEXED** to the City.

3. As there is no taxable property within the Property, the provisions of Minn. Stat. § 414.036 (2014) are not applicable.
