**ORDER APPROVING
ANNEXATION ORDINANCE**

On January 19, 2016, the City of Spring Grove (City) adopted Ordinance Number 2113 (Ordinance) which approved the Petition of Certain Persons for Annexation of Brent Sherburne, Jessica Sherburne, Michael Sherburne, and Carol Sherburne to annex certain real property (Property) legally described as follows:

Lot 65 in Second Church Addition to Spring Grove, Minnesota; EXCEPT that part of Lot 65 described as commencing at the Southwest Corner of said Lot 65, thence North 75 feet; thence East 190 feet; thence South 75 feet; thence West 190 feet to the point of beginning. Said parcel containing 3.67 acres more or less.

On October 7, 2015, Spring Grove Township (Township) adopted a waiver of objection to the annexation of the Property.

Based upon a review of the Ordinance, the Chief Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

ORDER

1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033 (2014), the Ordinance is deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly supports this Order.
2. Pursuant to the terms of the Ordinance and this Order, the Property is **ANNEXED** to the City.
3. Pursuant to agreement of the City and Township and as allowed by Minn. Stat. § 414.036 (2014), the City will reimburse the Township \$108 as stated in Ordinance Number 2113. There are no special assessments or debt incurred by the Township on the Property.
