In the Matter of the Annexation of Certain Real Property to the City of Willmar from Willmar Township (MBAU Docket A-7997)

ORDER APPROVING ANNEXATION ORDINANCE

On April 18, 2016, the City of Willmar (City) adopted Ordinance Number 1380 (Ordinance) annexing certain real property (Property) owned by William and Carole Cairns legally described as follows:

That part of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter, Section 21, Township 119 North, Range 35 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, Willmar Township, Kandiyohi County, Minnesota described as follows:

Commencing at the northwest corner of said Southwest Quarter; thence on an assumed bearing of South 89 degrees 41 minutes 40 seconds East, along the north line of said Southwest Quarter, a distance of 932.80 feet; thence on a bearing of South 0 degrees 16 minutes 39 seconds West a distance of 75.00 feet to the southerly boundary of the Highway right of way, which is the point of beginning of the land to be described; thence continuing on a bearing of South 0 degrees 16 minutes 39 seconds West a distance of 150.00 feet; thence on a bearing of North 89 degrees 41 minutes 40 seconds West a distance of 11.96 feet; thence on a bearing of South 0 degrees 30 minutes 08 seconds West, parallel with the east line of said Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter, a distance of 67.00 feet; thence on a bearing of South 89 degrees 41 minutes 40 seconds East, parallel with the north line of said Southwest Quarter, a distance of 200.00 feet; thence on a bearing of North 0 degrees 30 minutes 08 seconds East, parallel with the east line of said Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter, a distance of 217.00 feet to the southerly boundary of the Highway right of way; thence on a bearing of North 89 degrees 41 minutes 40 seconds West, along the southerly boundary of the Highway right of way, a distance of 188.63 feet to the point of beginning.

Based upon a review of the Ordinance, the Chief Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

ORDER

1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033 (2014), the Ordinance is deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly supports this Order.

2. Pursuant to the terms of the Ordinance and this Order, the Property is **ANNEXED** to the City.

3. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.036 (2014), the City will reimburse Willmar Township (Township) as stated in Ordinance Number 1380.
