**ORDER APPROVING  
ANNEXATION ORDINANCE**

On October 10, 2016, the City of Alexandria (City) adopted Ordinance Number 752 (Ordinance) which approved the Petition for Annexation of C & R Investments to annex certain real property (Property) legally described as follows:

Lot 8, Block 3 Evelyn Estates, except part in Alexandria City  
Ac .24 (adjoins 63-0118-885) Section 12, Twp 128, Range 38 AC 0.24


On October 3, 2016, LaGrand Township (Township) adopted a waiver of objection to the annexation of the Property.

Based upon a review of the Ordinance, the Chief Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

**ORDER**

1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033 (2016), the Ordinance is deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly support this Order.
2. Pursuant to the terms of the Ordinance and this Order, the Property is **ANNEXED** to the City.
3. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.036 (2016), the City will reimburse the Township \$7.84 each year for two years as stated in Ordinance 752.

## **NOTICE**

This Order is the final administrative order in this case under Minn. Stat. §§ 414.033, .07, .09, .12 (2016). Minn. Stat. § 414.033, subd. 7, requires that a copy of the annexation ordinance be filed with the township, the appropriate county auditor(s), and the Secretary of State.

Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.07, subd. 2, any person aggrieved by this Order may appeal to Douglas County District Court by filing an Application for Review with the Court Administrator within 30 days of this Order. An appeal does not stay the effect of this Order.

Any party may submit a written request for an amendment of this Order within seven days from the date of the mailing of the Order pursuant to Minn. R. 6000.3100 (2015). However, no request for amendment shall extend the time of appeal from this Order.
