Real Property to the City of Redwood Falls
from Honner Township (MBAU Docket A-8021)

**ORDER APPROVING
ANNEXATION ORDINANCE**

On October 4, 2016, the City of Redwood Falls (City) adopted Ordinance Number 52 (Ordinance) annexing certain real property (Property) from Honner Township (Township) legally described as follows:

Lot Three (3), of Hewitt's Addition, a subdivision to the County of Redwood and State of Minnesota, according to recorded plat thereof. Said tract is located in the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty-two (32), in Township One Hundred Thirteen (113), Range Thirty-five (35).

Based upon a review of the Ordinance, the Chief Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

ORDER

1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033 (2016), the Ordinance is deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly support this Order.
2. Pursuant to the terms of the Ordinance and this Order, the Property is **ANNEXED** to the City.
3. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.036 (2016), and agreed to by the Township in a letter dated October 17, 2016, the City will reimburse the Township as stated in Ordinance Number 52.

NOTICE

This Order is the final administrative order in this case under Minn. Stat. §§ 414.033, .07, .09, .12 (2016). Minn. Stat. § 414.033, subd. 7 requires that a copy of the annexation ordinance be filed with the township, the appropriate county auditor(s), and the Secretary of State.

Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.07, subd. 2, any person aggrieved by this Order may appeal to Redwood County District Court by filing an Application for Review with the Court Administrator within 30 days of this Order. An appeal does not stay the effect of this Order.

Any party may submit a written request for an amendment of this Order within seven days from the date of the mailing of the Order pursuant to Minn. R. 6000.3100 (2015). However, no request for amendment shall extend the time of appeal from this Order.
