ORDER APPROVING ANNEXATION ORDINANCE

On January 8, 2018, the City of Wilton (City) adopted Ordinance Number 2018-032 (Ordinance) annexing certain real property (Property) from Eckles Township (Township) legally described as follows:

That part of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE¼ of SE¼), Section Twenty-eight (28), Township One-Hundred Forty-seven (147), Range Thirty-four (34), which lies South of U.S. Highway No. 2; and less the Minneapolis, St. Paul and Sault Ste. Mari Railway right of way.

Based upon a review of the Ordinance, the Chief Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

ORDER

- 1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033 (2016), the Ordinance is deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly supports this Order.
- 2. Pursuant to the terms of the Ordinance and this Order, the Property is **ANNEXED** to the City.
- 3. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.036 (2016), the City will reimburse the Township \$103.00 the first year and \$102.97 the second year as stated in Ordinance Number 2018-032.
