**ORDER APPROVING  
ANNEXATION ORDINANCE**

On July 2, 2018, the City of Rochester (City) adopted Ordinance Number 4345 (Ordinance) annexing certain real property (Property) from Rochester Township (Township) legally described as follows:

That part of the Northwest Quarter of Section 22, Township 106 North, Range 14 West, Olmsted County, Minnesota, described as follows:

Commencing at the northwest corner of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 22; thence North 88 degrees 51 minutes 12 seconds East, assumed bearing, along the north line of said Northwest Quarter, 1037.25 feet; thence South 01 degree 33 minutes 48 seconds East, 242.00 feet; thence North 88 degrees 51 minutes 12 seconds East, 753.23 feet to the southwest corner of HENKE HEIGHTS SUBDIVISION; thence North 01 degrees 33 minutes 48 seconds West, along the west line of HENKE HEIGHTS SUBDIVISION, 242.00 feet to the north line of said Northwest Quarter; thence South 88 degrees 51 minutes 12 seconds West along said north line 753.23 feet to the point of beginning.

Containing 4.18 acres, more or less.

Based upon a review of the Ordinance, the Chief Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

**ORDER**

1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033 (2018), the Ordinance is deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly supports this Order.
2. Pursuant to the terms of the Ordinance and this Order, the Property is **ANNEXED** to the City.
3. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.036 (2018), the City will reimburse the Township as stated in Ordinance Number 4345.

4. The City must file a copy of the Annexation Ordinance with the Township, the appropriate county auditor(s), and the Secretary of State as required by Minn. Stat. § 414.033, subd. 7.

### **NOTICE**

Stat. § 414.07, subd. 2, any person aggrieved by this Order may appeal to Olmsted County District Court by filing an Application for Review with the Court Administrator within 30 days of this Order. An appeal does not stay the effect of this Order.

Any party may submit a written request for an amendment of this Order within seven days from the date of the mailing of the Order pursuant to Minn. R. 6000.3100 (2017). However, no request for amendment shall extend the time of appeal from this Order.
