**ORDER APPROVING
ANNEXATION ORDINANCE**

On October 9, 2018, the City of New York Mills (City) adopted Ordinance Number 130 (Ordinance) annexing certain real property (Property) from Newton Township (Township) legally described as follows:

Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter and the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter, Section 17, Township 135, Range 37 Otter Tail County, Minnesota.

Based upon a review of the Ordinance, the Chief Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

ORDER

1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033 (2018), the Ordinance is deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly supports this Order.
2. Pursuant to the terms of the Ordinance and this Order, the Property is **ANNEXED** to the City.
3. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.036 (2018), the City will reimburse the Township \$150 each year for two years as stated in Ordinance Number 130.
4. The City must file a copy of the Annexation Ordinance with the Township, the appropriate county auditor(s), and the Secretary of State as required by Minn. Stat. § 414.033, subd. 7.

NOTICE

This Order is the final administrative order in this case under Minn. Stat. §§ 414.033, .07, .09, .12 (2018). Pursuant to Minn. Any party may submit a written request for an amendment of this Order within seven days from the date of the mailing of the Order pursuant to Minn. R. 6000.3100 (2017). However, no request for amendment shall extend the time of appeal from this Order.
