ORDER APPROVING ANNEXATION ORDINANCE

On November 13, 2018, the City of Houston (City) adopted Ordinance Number 233 (Ordinance) annexing certain real property (Property) from Houston Township (Township) legally described as follows:

Lots 181, 182, 183, 184, and S¹/₂ Lot 185 - Block 17, Crookston's Addition, in Section 33, Township 104, Range 006, Houston County, Minnesota.

Based upon a review of the Ordinance, the Chief Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

ORDER

1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033 (2018), the Ordinance is deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly supports this Order.

2. Pursuant to the terms of the Ordinance and this Order, the Property is **ANNEXED** to the City.

3. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.036 (2018), the City will reimburse the Township \$932.69 each year for two years as stated in Ordinance Number 233.

4. The City must file a copy of the Annexation Ordinance with the Township, the appropriate county auditor(s), and the Secretary of State as required by Minn. Stat. § 414.033, subd. 7.
