In the Matter of the Annexation of Certain Real Property to the City of Hills from Martin Township (MBAU Docket A-8244)

ORDER APPROVING ANNEXATION ORDINANCE

On November 12, 2019, the City of Hills (City) adopted Ordinance No. 21 (Ordinance) annexing certain real property (Property) from Martin Township legally described as follows:

A tract of land in the Southwest Quarter (SW1/4) of Section Twenty-one (21), Township One Hundred One (101) North, Range Forty-six (46) West of the 5th P.M., Rock County, Minnesota, described as follows:

Commencing at the South Quarter Corner of said Section 21; thence South 89 degrees 52 minutes 09 seconds West (Geodetic Bearing) along the South Line of the Southwest Quarter of said Section a distance of 263.48 feet; thence North 00 degrees 06 minutes 37 seconds West a distance of 40.00 feet to an iron stake; thence continuing North 00 degrees 06 minutes 37 seconds West a distance of 150.16 feet to an iron stake; thence North 00 degrees 05 minutes 18 seconds East a distance of 149.36 feet to an iron stake; thence North 00 degrees 16 minutes 21 seconds West a distance of 40.00 feet to the point of beginning; thence North 00 degrees 16 minutes 21 seconds West a distance of 234.00 feet; thence North 89 degrees 52 minutes 09 seconds East a distance of 234.00 feet; thence South 00 degrees 52 minutes 09 seconds West a distance of 78.00 feet to the point of beginning.

Based upon a review of the Ordinance, the Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

ORDER

- 1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033 (2018), the Ordinance is deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly supports this Order.
- 2. Pursuant to the terms of the Ordinance and this Order, the Property is **ANNEXED** to the City.

- 3. Pursuant to the agreement of the parties and as allowed by Minn. Stat. § 414.036 (2018), the City will reimburse the Township \$69.49 in one payment.
- 4. The City must file a copy of the Annexation Ordinance with the Township, the appropriate county auditor, and the Secretary of State as required by Minn. Stat. § 414.033, subd. 7.
