In the Matter of the Annexation of Certain Real Property to the City of Zumbrota from Zumbrota Township (MBAU Docket A-8360)

ORDER APPROVING ANNEXATION ORDINANCE

On September 16, 2021, the City of Zumbrota (City) adopted Ordinance No. 2021-02 (Ordinance) annexing certain real property (Property) from Zumbrota Township (Township) legally described as follows:

Lot 23 of Auditor's Subdivision of the Southwest Quarter (SW¼) of Section 30, Township 110 North, Range 15 West; and 7.83 acres, more or less of the East Half (E½) of Northwest Quarter (NW¼) of Section 30, Township 110 North, Rang 15 West, described as follows: Beginning at a point on the west line of said East Half (E½) of the Northwest Quarter (NW¼) at a distance of 995.30 feet north of the southwest corner of said East Half (E½) of the Northwest Quarter (NW¼) for a place of beginning, running thence east to the center of the Red Wing-Zumbrota Road, so-called; thence southwesterly along the center of the Road to the south line of said East Half (E½) of the Northwest Quarter (NW¼), thence west along the south line to the southwest corner of said East Half (E½) of the Northwest Quarter (NW¼), thence north along the said west line to the place of beginning, Goodhue County, Minnesota excepting the MN 58 right-of-way.

Based upon a review of the Ordinance, the Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

ORDER

1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033 (2020), the Ordinance is deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly supports this Order.

2. Pursuant to the terms of the Ordinance and this Order, the Property is **ANNEXED** to the City.

3. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.036 (2020), the City will reimburse the Township \$40.63 each year for two years as stated in Ordinance No. 2021-02.

4. The City must file a copy of the Annexation Ordinance with the Township, the appropriate county auditor(s), and the Secretary of State as required by Minn. Stat. § 414.033, subd. 7.
