In the Matter of the Annexation of Certain Real Property to the City of Mazeppa from Mazeppa Township (MBAU Docket A-8383)

ORDER APPROVING ANNEXATION ORDINANCE

On January 12, 2022, the City of Mazeppa (City) adopted Ordinance No. 2021-05 (Ordinance) annexing certain real property (Property) from Mazeppa Township (Township) legally described as follows:

That part of the Southwest Quarter of Section 5, Township 109 North, Range 14 West, Wabasha County, Minnesota, described as follows:

Commencing at the northwest corner of said Southwest Quarter of Section 5; thence South 01 degree 22 minutes 45 seconds East, assumed bearing along the west line of said Southwest Quarter of Section 5, a distance of 227.86 feet to the point of beginning of the land to be described; thence continue South 01 degree 22 minutes 45 seconds East a distance of 319.73 feet to the northwest corner of Outlot C, SCENIC HEIGHTS SUBDIVISION, on file and of record in the Office of the County Recorder, Wabasha County, Minnesota; thence South 66 degrees 12 minutes 37 seconds East, a distance of 125.64 feet; thence South 01 degree 22 minutes 45 seconds East, a distance of 50.77 feet; thence South 59 degrees 27 minutes 53 seconds East, a distance of 238.19 feet; thence North 36 degrees 08 minutes 38 seconds East, a distance of 306.08 feet to the most northerly corner of said Outlet C; thence North 59 degrees 56 minutes 22 seconds West, a distance of 588.76 feet to the point of beginning. Containing 3.23 acres, more or less.

Based upon a review of the Ordinance, the Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

ORDER

- 1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033 (2020), the Ordinance is deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly supports this Order.
- 2. Pursuant to the terms of the Ordinance and this Order, the Property is **ANNEXED** to the City.
- 3. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.036 (2020), the City will reimburse the Township \$4.35 each year for two years as stated in Ordinance No. 2021-05.

4. The City must file a copy of the Annexation Ordinance with the Township, the appropriate county auditor(s), and the Secretary of State as required by Minn. Stat. § 414.033, subd. 7.
