**ORDER APPROVING
ANNEXATION ORDINANCE**

On November 20, 2024, the City of Lindstrom (City) adopted Ordinance No. 20241120-04 (Ordinance) which approved the Gerald Chapman Petition for Annexation pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033, subd. 5 (2024), to annex certain real property (Property) from Chisago Lake Township (Township) legally described as follows:

Lots 6 and 7, Gerurb Beach, Chisago County, Minnesota


No objection was received from the Township.

Based upon a review of the Ordinance, the Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

ORDER

1. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.033 (2024), the Ordinance is deemed adequate in all legal respects and properly supports this Order.
2. Pursuant to the terms of the Ordinance and this Order, the Property is **ANNEXED** to the City.
3. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.036 (2024), the City shall reimburse the Township \$678.13 each year for four years as stated in the Ordinance.
4. The City must file a copy of the Annexation Ordinance with the Township, the appropriate county auditor, and the Secretary of State as required by Minn. Stat. § 414.033, subd. 7.

NOTICE
