NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT JOINTLY RESOLVED AND AGREED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CLOUD AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAUK RAPIDS, MINNESOTA THAT:

- 1. The property as described as located within the City of Sauk Rapids on the attached Exhibit A is hereby detached from the City of Sauk Rapids and annexed to the City of St. Cloud.
- 2. The land is shown on the map attached as Exhibit B.
- 3. The quantity of land described above is approximately 0.75 acres.
- 4. The Municipal Board is hereby requested to order the concurrent detachment and annexation of the above described property.
