WHEREAS, The City of St. Bonifacius has a long established policy that the City will not extend utility service outside City limits, and

WHEREAS, The City of St. Bonifacius is able to service its residents by providing City water and sewer services, and;

WHEREAS, Gerald and Cynthia Weinzierl intend to petition to annex to St. Bonifacius.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of St. Bonifacius, County of Hennepin, State of Minnesota, that the City of St. Bonifacius is willing to provide City sewer and water to the property if it is detached from Minnetrista and attached to St. Bonifacius by approval from the Minnesota Municipal Board.

RESOLUTION DENYING A DETACHMENT REQUEST AS SUBMITTED BY CYNTHIA AND GERALD WEINZERL

WHEREAS, the City of Minnetrista is a municipal coporation, organized and existing under the laws of the State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes 414.061 sets forth the procedure for annexation/detachment;

WHEREAS, the City of Minnetrista received a request from Cynthia and Gerald Weinzerl for detachment from the City of Minnetrista to be annexed into the City of St. Bonifacius;

WHEREAS, the property is legally described as:

Commencing at the Northeast corner of the Northwest 1/4 then West 120 feet then South 114 feet to the Northerly line of State Highway 7 then Southeasterly along said Highway line to the East line of the Northwest 1/4 then North 168 feet to beginning

WHEREAS, the City was seeking a cooperative agreement to access sewer service from the City of St. Bonifacius, to resolve a failing septic system;

WHEREAS, the City of St. Bonifacius passed Resolution 1995-27 approving an annexation petition which in effect denied a cooperative agreement for sewer service;

WHEREAS, the City of Minnetrista believes that the proposed annexation would not be in the best interest of either cities;

WHEREAS, the City Council felt that a detachment from the City of Minnetrista would set a precedence for allowing St. Bonifacius to annex other portions of the City of Minnetrista;

WHEREAS, the City of Minnetrista has accomplished cooperative agreements with the City of Mound to provide sewer service to properties within Minnetrista;

WHEREAS, the City of Minnetrista deems the sewer system as a regional function controlled by the Metropolitan Waste Control Commission and the access to sewer should not be exclusive of city boundaries;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Minnetrista hereby denies the detachment from Minnetrista as requested by Cynthia and Gerald Weinzerl based on the facts outlined above.

This resolution was adopted by the City Council of the City of Minnetrista on the 21st day of August 1995, by a vote of 4 Ayes and 1 Nays Tacheny - nay.

RESOLUTION RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO 114-95 DENYING DETACHMENT REQUEST AS SUBMITTED BY CYNTHIA AND GERALD WEINZIERL AND APPROVE THE CONCURRENT DETACHMENT/ANNEXATION PETITION

WHEREAS, the City of Minnetrista is a municipal corporation, organized and existing under the laws of the State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes 414.061 sets forth the procedure for annexation/detachment;

WHEREAS, the City of Minnetrista received a request from Cynthia and Gerald Weinzierl for detachment from the City of Minnetrista to be annexed into the City of St. Bonifacius; and

WHEREAS, the property is legally described as:

Commencing at the Northeast corner of the Northwest 1/4 then West 120 feet then South 114 feet to the Northerly line of State Highway 7 then Southeasterly along said Highway line to the East line of the Northwest 1/4 then North 168 feet to beginning

WHEREAS, the City was seeking a cooperative agreement to access sewer service from the City of St. Bonifacius, to resolve a failing septic system; and

WHEREAS, the City of St. Bonifacius passed Resolution 1995-27 approving an annexation petition which in effect denied a cooperative agreement for sewer service; and

WHEREAS, the City of Minnetrista believed that the proposed annexation would not be in the best interest of either cities; and

WHEREAS, the City Council felt that a detachment from the City of Minnetrista would set a precedence for allowing St. Bonifacius to annex other portions of the City of Minnetrista, therefore Resolution No. 114-95 -RESOLUTION DENYING A DETACHMENT REQUEST AS SUBMITTED BY CYNTHIA AND GERALD WEINZIERL was approved on August 21, 1995; and

WHEREAS, Cynthia and Gerald Weinzierl have investigated all possible ways to correct and resolve the problem that exists with their failing septic system but to no avail; and Resolution No. 30-96 Page 2

WHEREAS, St. Bonifacius continues to be unwilling to allow Cynthia and Gerald Weinzierl to connect to the St. Bonifacius municipal sewer but will allow the connection if the Weinzierls are successful in detaching their above-named parcel from Minnetrista and annexing to St. Bonifacius; and

WHEREAS, Cynthia and Gerald Weinzierl in order to resolve their sewer problem have petitioned the Minnesota Municipal Board (MMB) for a concurrent detachment/annexation; and

WHEREAS, the City of Minnetrista still believes that the proposed detachment/annexation would not be in the best interest of either city, but recognizes the hardship faced by Cynthia and Gerald Weinzierl; and

WHEREAS, the City of Minnetrista does not want Cynthia and Gerald Weinzierl to be a pawn in the annexation dispute between the cities of Minnetrista and St. Bonifacius as a result of the City of St. Bonifacius' unreasonable refusal to allow municipal connections, even though Minnetrista has entered into similar agreements with other surrounding communities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Minnetrista believes that opposing the detachment/annexation would result in Cynthia and Gerald Weinzierl incurring unnecessary and substantial expenses; and

WHEREAS, the City of Minnetrista believes that its decision to rescind its prior resolution opposing the detachment/annexation should not be used as adverse precedent in further annexation proceedings and requests that St. Bonifacius should adopt a similar position.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Minnetrista hereby rescinds Resolution No. 114-95 and approves and supports the concurrent detachment/annexation petition submitted to the MMB by Cynthia and Gerald Weinzierl.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the MMB be requested to move quickly on the Weinzierl petition and that the MMB and the City of St. Bonifacius agree that the application shall not set a precedent on future detachment or annexation requests.




