TO: The Board of Supervisors of St. Martin Township:

We, the undersigned, being the sole fee owners of the real estate described below, hereby request the entities above agree to the detachment of this real estate from the City of St. Martin and returned to the Township of St. Martin and to extend the Township's boundaries to include the same, and for that purpose respectfully state:

1. The real estate to be detached consists of lands which are unplatted, and consists of approximately 80 acres in area. All of the real estate lies entirely within Stearns County, Minnesota, and is legally described as follows:


The South Half of the Southeast Quarter (S ½ SE ¼), Section 36, Township 124 North, Range 32 West, Stearns County, Minnesota

2. There are no buildings on the real estate, and no person resides on the real estate. Further, to the knowledge of petitioners, there are no municipal improvements on the real estate or in the immediate vicinity of the real estate.

3. All of this real estate is rural in character and is not developed for urban residential, commercial, or industrial purposes, and it is currently within the boundaries of the City of St. Martin.

and that copies of the Petition and this Resolution be forwarded to the Minnesota Municipal Board for the purpose of approving the detachment of this property from the City of St. Martin.

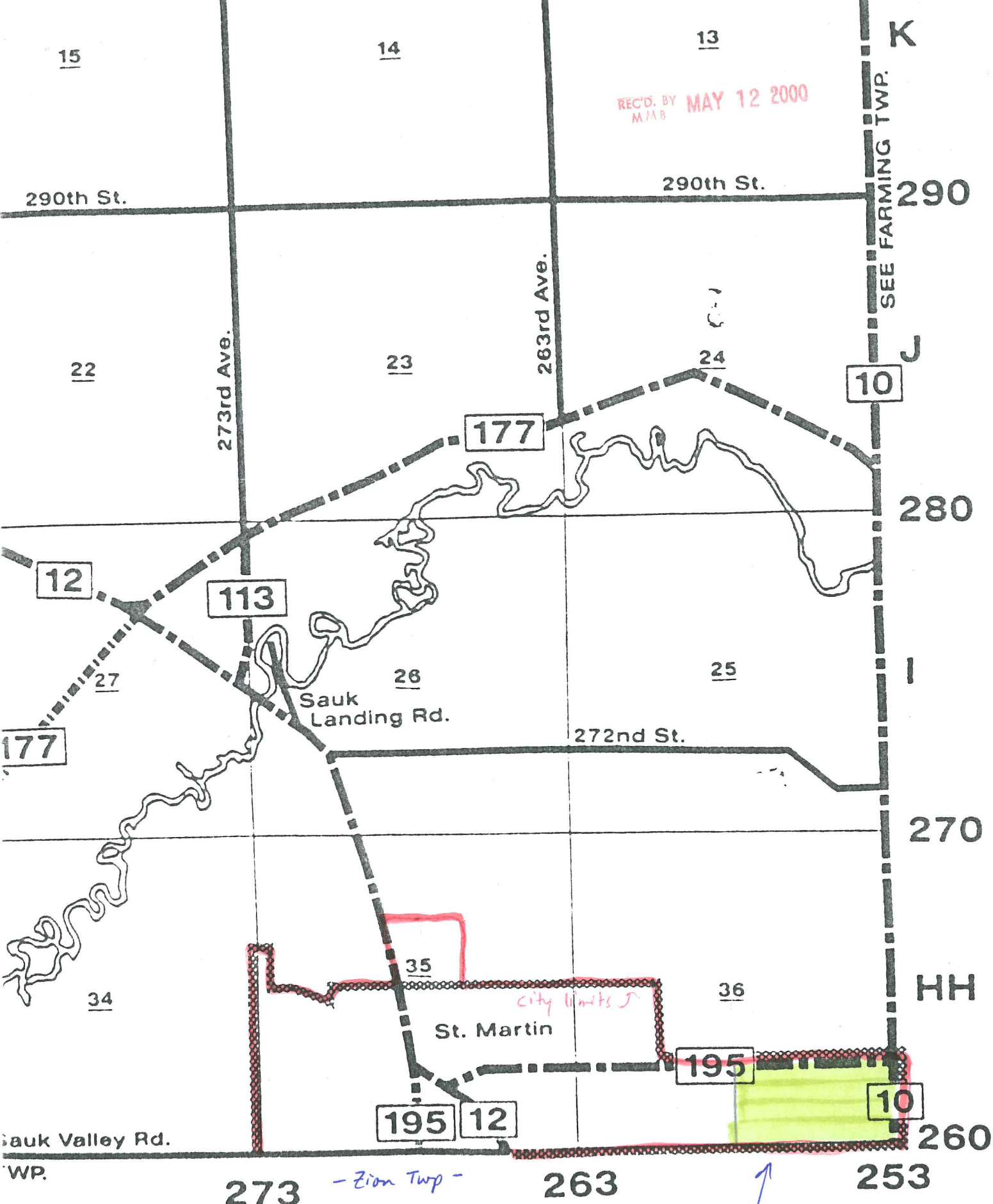
