Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 414, as amended, before the Director of the Office of Strategic and Long Range Planning, or designee, in the above-entitled matter.

The hearing will convene at 1:00 p.m. on the 9th day of November, 2000, in the Cook City Hall, 127 South River Street, Cook, Minnesota, and be immediately continued indefinitely. All persons shall be given an opportunity to be heard orally and to submit written data, statements or arguments concerning the above-entitled matter. The right to testify and the admission of testimony and other evidence shall be governed by the Rules of the Minnesota Municipal Board. [The Rules of the Minnesota Municipal Board may be purchased from the Documents Section, 117 University Avenue, St. Paul, Minnesota 55155, (651) 297-3000.]

The property proposed for detachment is described as follows:

That part of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NE 1/4 of NE 1/4 of SE 1/4), of Section Eighteen (18), Township Sixty-two (62) North, Range Eighteen (18) West described as follows: Assuming the East boundary of said NE 1/4 of NE 1/4 of SE 1/4 to lie North 00 degrees 30'24" West, and from the Southeast Corner of said NE 1/4 of NE 1/4 of SE 1/4, which is also the


point of beginning; run North 00 degrees 30'24" West along said East boundary a distance of 217.25 feet; thence North 89 degrees 46'54" West parallel to the South boundary of said NE ¼ of NE ¼ of SE ¼ a distance of 518.11 feet; thence South 00 degrees 19'00" East a distance of 217.27 feet to a point which lies on the South boundary of said NE ¼ of NE ¼ of SE ¼; thence South 89 degrees 46'54" East along said South boundary a distance of 518.83 feet back to the point of beginning

After all testimony is complete and the record is closed, the Director of the Office of Strategic and Long Range Planning, or designee, will issue its findings and order in accordance with Minnesota Statutes Chapter 414.
