TO MINNESOTA STATUTES 414) CONCLUSIONS OF LAW
) AND ORDER

On June 3, 2003, Municipal Boundary Adjustments received a resolution for detachment of certain land from the City of Willmar.

After review of the resolution, the Acting Director hereby makes and files the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. That a resolution was duly filed with the Department of Administration for the detachment of property by the City of Willmar.
2. The petition and resolution contained all the information required by statute including a description of the territory proposed for detachment, which is as follows:

The West Half of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (W1/2 of NW1/4 of SE1/4); and that part of the West Half of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (W1/2 of SW1/4 of NE1/4) lying southerly of Minnesota Trunk Highway 23 and 71 bypass, all in Section 27, Township 119, Range 35.
3. The area proposed for detachment is situated within the City of Willmar and abuts the municipal boundary.
4. The area proposed for detachment is approximately 21.5 acres.
5. The area proposed for detachment is rural in character and not developed for urban residential, commercial, or industrial purposes.

6. There are no buildings or municipal improvements needed on the area proposed for detachment.

7. The area abuts the Town of Willmar, Kandiyohi County.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Department of Administration has duly acquired and now has jurisdiction of the within proceeding.


2. An order should be issued by the Acting Director detaching the area described herein.
