PURSUANT TO MINNESOTA STATUTES 414) AND ORDER

On June 9, 2003, Municipal Boundary Adjustments received a joint resolution from the Cities of Corcoran and Maple Grove, requesting the concurrent detachment and annexation of certain properties between the two cities pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 414.061.

After review of the resolution, the Acting Director hereby makes and files the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. That a resolution requesting concurrent detachment and annexation of certain properties was received from the Cities of Corcoran and Maple Grove.

2. The resolution contained all the information required by statute including a description of the territory proposed for concurrent detachment and annexation, which is as follows:

Lot 10, Block 1, Appaloosa Woods Third Addition Subdivision.

3. The area proposed for concurrent detachment and annexation is situated within the Cities of Corcoran and Maple Grove and abut the municipal boundaries of said cities.

4. On July 18, 2003, the Acting Director reviewed the joint resolutions and all pertinent information contained in the files for concurrent detachment and annexation.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Department of Administration has duly acquired and now has jurisdiction of the within proceedings.

2. An order should be issued by the Acting Director concurrently detaching and annexing the area described herein.

ORDER

1. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the property described in Findings of Fact 2 be, and the same hereby is, detached from the City of Corcoran and annexed to the City of Maple Grove, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof.
