WHEREAS, on April 30, 2007, Municipal Boundary Adjustments received a petition for the detachment of certain land from the City of Annandale and City Resolution No. 07-10 supporting the petition for detachment; and

WHEREAS, Reorganization Order No. 192, effective March 8, 2005, has transferred the duties of the Director to the Chief Administrative Law Judge; and

After review of the petition and resolution, the Chief Administrative Law Judge hereby makes and files the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. That a petition and city resolution were duly filed with the Office of Administrative Hearings-Municipal Boundary Adjustments for the detachment of property from the City of Annandale.
- 2. The petition and city resolution contained all the information required by statute including a description of the territory proposed for detachment, which is as follows:
 - Lot 1, Block 7, Southbrook Golf and Country Club Third Addition, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the Office of the Wright County Recorder.
- The area proposed for detachment is situated within the City of Annandale and abuts the municipal boundary.

- 4. The area proposed for detachment is approximately 9.04 acres.
- 5. The area proposed for detachment is rural in character and not developed for urban residential, commercial, or industrial purposes.
- 6. There are no municipal improvements needed on the area proposed for detachment.
 - 7. The area abuts the Town of Southside, Wright County.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Office of Administrative Hearings has duly acquired and now has jurisdiction of the within proceeding.
- 2. An order should be issued by the Chief Administrative Law Judge detaching the area described herein.

ORDER

1. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the property described in Findings of Fact 2 be, and the same hereby is, detached from the City of Annandale and made a part of the Town of Southside, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof.
