AMENDED FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS AND DECISION

This matter comes before Administrative Law Judge Raymond R. Krause on the City of Rockville's Motion for Amended Findings of Fact, Conclusions and Order. The Motion was filed on November 10, 2008. An Objection to the Motion was filed by the Township of Maine Prairie on November 14, 2008. A motion hearing was set for December 2, 2008, by telephone.

Peter Tiede, Esq., Murnane Brandt P.A., represented Maine Prairie Township (the Township). James A. Mogen, Rinke Noonan Law Firm, represented the City of Rockville (the City). Harry E. Burns, Burns Law Office, represented the Petitioners.

In the course of the motion hearing, the Township withdrew its objection to the Motion. The parties all agreed to the proposed terms of the Amended Decision. There being no further issues in contention, the Motion was granted and the hearing adjourned.

Based on the agreement of the parties, the Administrative Law Judge makes the following:

DECISION

1. Order Number 1 of the Decision filed on October 30, 2008,¹ in this matter is amended to add the following: The Petition for Detachment is Denied with respect to the area generally defined by the following boundary:

Starting at the northeast corner of Section 32, westerly along the north section line of Section 32 to the point of intersection with the centerline of County Road 8. Then, southerly along said centerline of County Road 8 to the intersection with the centerline of Grand Lake Road. Then, easterly along the centerline of Grand Lake Road to the intersection with the north

section line of Section 33. Then, westerly along the north section line of Section 33 to the point of beginning.

- 2. The City is hereby ordered to obtain a survey of the area excluded from detachment from a registered surveyor that is acceptable to both the City and the Township, and to file that survey with the Office of Administrative Hearings, Municipal Boundary Adjustments Unit, to identify the excluded portion of the detachment petition.
- 3. All other Findings of Fact, Conclusions and Orders of the Decision filed October 30, 2008, remain in effect.
- 4. Office of Administrative Hearings costs associated with this proceeding shall be divided equally between the City and the Township.
