- 6. The reason detachment is requested is to redefine the City of Woodbury north corporate limits to reflect the construction of I-94 and to clarify public safety response responsibilities.
- 7. The number of residents in the area proposed for detachment is zero.
- 8. There are no buildings on said property to be detached from the City of Woodbury.

9. Public improvements on said property are Manning Avenue (TH95 and County State Aid Highway 15).
