
Dear Mr. Armstrong, Ms. Agrimson, Mr. Vivian and Ms. Wallberg:

After reviewing all pertinent correspondence in the file, the Chief Administrative Law Judge, through his designee, delegated the authority and responsibility under Minn. Stat. §§ 414.01 to 414.09 to conduct hearings and issue orders, including a final decision in this matter to the Administrative Law Division, pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.12 Subd. 1(b). The Office of Administrative Hearings will assign an administrative law judge to schedule a hearing in this matter. You will be notified accordingly.

Although the parties are not ordered to engage in a specific alternative resolution process, they are encouraged to engage in discussions and attempt to resolve this matter prior to a hearing. Considering the limited number of parties and the size of the parcel of land at issue, an agreed upon resolution may be attainable.
