Dear Ms. Murphy and Ms. Paulson:

The Office of Administrative Hearings - Municipal Boundary Adjustment Unit acknowledges receipt of City Resolution No. 5775 and the above-referenced petitions for detachment. Please refer to the above docket number in future communications regarding this proposed boundary adjustment.

Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.06 Subd. 1a and 2, as amended and effective August 1, 2012:

- If a city resolution supporting the detachment petition is received and no resolution of opposition is received from the township, no hearing is necessary and the Chief Administrative Law Judge shall grant the petition.
- If both the city and the township submit resolutions opposing the detachment petition, a hearing must not be held and the Chief Administrative Law Judge shall deny the petition.
- In any other case, the Chief Administrative Law Judge shall designate a time and place for a hearing pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.09.

Because there is considerable paperwork and expense with a hearing, the MBAU would appreciate hearing from the township as to their position on the detachment petitions by October 16, 2012.

Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.06 Subd. 1a, as amended and effective August 1, 2012:

■ The Township may submit a resolution stating that the Town Board supports, opposes or is neutral to the petition. The failure to submit a resolution must be deemed a position of neutrality. Minn. Stat. § 414.06 Subd. 1a.
