FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW, AND ORDER

The detachment petition of the property owner along with supporting resolutions from the City of Blooming Prairie and Blooming Prairie Township were reviewed for conformity with applicable law. By delegation, the Chief Administrative Law Judge hereby makes and files the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On March 14, 2013, the Chief Administrative Law Judge or authorized designee reviewed the petition and supporting city and township resolutions which were duly filed with the Office of Administrative Hearings-Municipal Boundary Adjustment Unit on January 17, 2013, February 12, 2013, and March 12, 2013, respectively.
- 2. The petition and supporting resolutions contained all the information required by statute including a description of the territory proposed for detachment, which is as follows:

South Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 36, Township 105 North, Range 19 West, Steele County, Minnesota.

- 3. The area proposed for detachment is situated within the City of Blooming Prairie and abuts the common boundary between the City of Blooming Prairie and Blooming Prairie Township, Steele County.
 - 4. The area proposed for detachment is rural in character and not developed

for urban residential, commercial, or industrial purposes.

5. The area proposed for detachment is approximately 80 acres.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Office of Administrative Hearings has duly acquired and now has jurisdiction of the within proceeding.
- 2. An order should be issued by the Chief Administrative Law Judge or authorized designee detaching the area described herein.

ORDER

1. The property described in Findings of Fact 2 is detached from the City of Blooming Prairie and made a part of Blooming Prairie Township, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof.
