

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LEWISVILLE
FOR DETACHMENT OF CERTAIN LAND
PURSUANT TO MINNESOTA STATUTES § 414.06

The City of LEWISVILLE hereby requests by resolution the Office of Administrative Hearings-Municipal Boundary Adjustment Unit to detach certain properties described herein from the City of LEWISVILLE and make a part of the Township of ANTRIM.

1. The property is situated within the City of LEWISVILLE, abuts the municipal boundary, and is located in the County of WATONWAN.
The petitioned area abuts on the city's N S E W (circle one) boundary(ies).
2. The property proposed for detachment is rural in character and not developed for urban residential, commercial, or industrial purposes.
3. The reason detachment is requested is: There is no water, sewer, or road maintenance. As a result of this lack of service it would be of most benefit to the land owner to have the lower taxes afforded by the township.

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5. The number of acres in the property proposed for detachment is 21.97 and is described as follows:

Lot B of Auditor's Subdivision of the Village of Lewisville, Watonwan County, Minnesota, as located in the South One-Half of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 4

6. The number and character of buildings on said property is NONE
7. The number of residents in the area proposed for detachment is one (1)
(The number of residents is not necessarily the same as number of owners.)
8. Public improvements on said property are NONE
